## MANAGEMENT OF THE NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION FROM OCTOBER 2014

- 1. In January 2014, the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statements (CAPS) will be implemented in Grade 12.
- 2. Considering the above, the National Senior Certificate Examination in 2013 and its subsequent Supplementary Examination in February 2014 will be the last examinations to be conducted in terms of the Subject Statements, Learning Programme Guidelines and Subject Assessment Guidelines.
- 3. This, therefore implies that all repeat candidates and part-time candidates enrolling for the 2014 National Senior Certificate Examinations will have to change from the National Curriculum Statement Grades 10-12 as set out in the Subject Statements, Learning Programme Guidelines and Subject Assessment Guidelines, to the Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statements of the National Curriculum Statement Grades R-12.
