For each candidate you must please have the following on display:-

1) PAT TASK 1 (Term 1 prac), PAT TASK 3 (Term 2 prac), PAT TASK 5 (T

for each of these the following must be presented:

- an A3 tonal drawing (loose or in sourcebook)
- other design process work (in sourcebook)
- final product.
- 2) The June Practical Exam (a smaller practical task that was done during the June exam in a 6 hour session)
- 3) September Practical Exam (see note on this exam later in this document)
- 4) The Final Practical Exam (National)
- 4.1 Design Process Work (in sourcebook). This could include a tonal drawing but a carefully rendered design or prototype for the final product is also acceptable.
- 4.2 Final Design Product

Each candidate's sourcebook must display:

- A completed GRADE 12 DESIGN LEARNER PORTFOLIO COVER PROGRAMME OF ASSESSMENT MARK SHEET (See ADDENDUM I) with moderated marks in
- the practical Brief for each Task/Prac Exam
- the rubrics which were used to mark these tasks.

Also have the CASS RECORDING SHEET (ADDENDUM II) and the final Moderation Mark sheet (ADDENDUM III) completed and available on the day of moderation. It will help to simplify the moderation process and moderator and final marks will be filled in on them (to be attached to the coloured computerized mark sheets).

The two coloured computerized mark sheets from the Education Department must be available with only the teacher's column filled in - in black. The one mark sheet requests the PAT mark out of 50 which is the exhibition mark (Task 1, 3, 5 as well as the prac exams - recalculated to 50). The November prac exam of 100 marks will be filled onto the other sheet. Your principal should already have handed in the CASS mark sheet at the district office.

Works must be exhibited in numerical order. The educator must give each candidate a number and these numbers as well as Examination numbers must be reflected on the Final Moderation Mark sheet (ADDENDUM III). Each exhibition must display the candidates EXAMINATION NUMBER.

Ensure that:-

- Tasks are exhibited in the right order Task 1, Task3 and Task 5.
- Tasks are clearly labeled Task, 1, Task 3 and Task 5.
- The Practical exams form part of this exhibition and are also clearly labeled, June, September and November.

### PLEASE TAKE NOTE:

- All works must be displayed. Missing works cannot receive a mark.
- The September exam practical is the Design P2 September exam that has been sent out by the Department and must be done during the September 6 hours in a time decided between the Design teacher and the principal

- The Design Final Moderation Mark sheet (ADDENDUM III) requires of you to get an average mark for all the Practical Year work. We want to compare that mark with your End-of-Year Exhibition mark. - We will not remark each individual work, unless we feel that the average of the candidate is too high or too low when looking at his/her body of work.
