GRADE 12 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC) EXAMINATION – REGISTER FOR ELECTRONIC DEVICES

1. This Assessment Instruction has the reference to National Examination Instruction 47 of 2021.
2. Cellphones and other electronic devices are being used increasingly by some candidates in the facilitation of examination irregularities. It has therefore been agreed that:
 - a) All candidates will be required to complete the Register for Electronic Devices, which will be managed by the school.
 - b) The Register for Electronic Devices will require all candidates to record all details of the cellphone or any other electronic device that they will be using during the examination period.

- c) If the cellphone or any other device is changed during the examination period, this must be brought to the attention of the school principal.
- d) In the event that the learner has more than one device, then the details of all the devices must be recorded.
3. By completing the Register for Electronic Devices the candidate provides, in terms of Section 11(c) of the Protection of Personal Information Act, 2013 (Act No. 4 of 2013) (POPIA), his/her consent that the personal information of the candidate may be used for the purposes of writing and administration of the National Senior Certificate Examinations.
4. Furthermore, the candidate is reminded that it is his/her responsibility to report any information or rumour regarding examination irregularities to the examination hotline established for this purpose. The examination hotline will be a 24-hour service. In addition to reporting to the examination hotline, this information must be brought to the attention of the school principal. Failure to do so will be considered to be collusion, for which the candidate will be held accountable. The WhatsApp hotline number is 069 335 2818.
