ANNUAL NATIONAL ASSESSMENT (ANA)

A. CAPTURING OF DATA

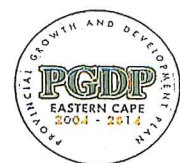
1. The entries of learners were captured through SASAMS and uploaded to LURITTS and then uploaded to the GET Mainframe system. There were problems with the uploading of data from SASAMS to LURITTS as some schools did not assign classes and subjects to learners
2. It is evident that not all schools data have been uploaded to the GET Mainframe system.
3. Preliminary Schedules were printed from the mainframe and issued to Districts on 12 August 2014.
4. Schools must update their SASAMS databases with these amendments.



5. It is important that the SASAMS databases are updated as the marks will be captured on the SASAMS databases after the marking of the Annual National Assessment test.
6. A new patch 14.2 was issued for SASAMS. Schools are to ensure that this patch is installed before they commence the capture of marks.

B. ADMINISTRATION OF ANA

7. The manual for the administration of the Annual National Assessment was issued to all schools during the training sessions held by Districts.
8. Schools are advised to let Grade 3 learners write in lid pencils or ball pen during the writing of ANA tests.
9. Universal ANA will be written in all schools from Grades 1-6 and 9
10. Verification of ANA is the most important part of the Annual National Assessment as the Minister of Education will report on this.
11. An independent service provider was appointed by the Department of Basic Education to conduct the verification ANA in the country.
12. This service provider will appoint Provincial and District coordinators and field workers to administer the verification ANA.
13. In Grades 7 and 8 the field workers will administer the tests. In all other Grades, the tests will be administered by the educators and will be monitored by the field workers.
14. It will happen that a school could have a maximum of 3 field workers if their school has been chosen and they have Grades 7, 8 and 9.
15. A sample of 25 scripts will be taken away from the school after the test has been administered.
16. Principals are to keep a record of these scripts as they will be returned to the District office by the 15 November 2014.
17. The independent agent will not take any script that has been identified for moderation. The selected scripts for moderation are indicated on the mark sheet.
18. The Independent agent will undertake question by question analysis and report on this to the Minister of Education.
19. Schools are expected to provide a report to parents in respect of the Annual National Assessment Test. This can be generated from SASAMS.

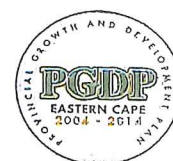


C. SAMPLED SCHOOLS

20. A sample of schools will write ANA in Grades 7 and 8 in 2014.
21. The sampled schools that will participate in the verification of ANA for all Grades are attached as (Annexure A).

D. MARKING OF ANA SCRIPTS

22. ANA Assessment Instruction 03 of 2014 issued by the Department of Basic Education deals with Cascading marking guideline discussions of ANA for Grades 3, 6 and 9.
23. The Marking Guideline Discussion for Grades 3, 6 and 9 took place with the Chief Markers in Johannesburg on the 7-11 July 2014.
24. A marking guideline discussion for Grades 3, 6 and 9 will take place from the 8-12 September 2014 at Cluster level with Subject Advisors.
25. Every school must attend the Marking Guideline discussions for Grades 3, 6 and 9 which will take place from the 16 to 19 September 2014.
26. **IT IS COMPULSORY THAT ALL SCHOOLS WRITE THE ANNUAL NATIONAL ASSESSMENT TESTS.**
27. Independent or Private schools that are obtaining a subsidy from the Department must write the Annual National Assessment in either Grades 3, 6 or 9 which ever is the highest grade in the school.
28. Independent or Private schools must not mark the tests but submit them directly to the District offices for these to be submitted to the moderation centres for marking.
29. The sample script for moderation for Grades 3, 6 and 9 has been pre selected by the computer. On the mark sheets in the Provincial re-Mark column will be blank. In the event the selected learner is absent a replacement has been selected. This is indicated by *** in the Provincial Re-Mark column.
30. After the writing of the tests and after attending the marking guideline discussions all learners' test papers must be marked by the educators at the school except those taken for Verification ANA by the service provider.



31. After all scripts have been marked the mark sheets must be completed and the sample scripts together with all the mark sheets must be submitted to the District Office between the 25- 30 September 2014.
32. Thereafter the schools must capture all learners' marks on the SASAMS database and these databases must be submitted to the EMIS Coordinators in the District before the closing of schools on 03 October 2014.
33. The latest patch (version 14.2.0) or later should be used to capture the ANA results.
34. The, verified and approved by three individuals
35. The new version will also require schools to change their default administrator password, which is set to "admin" after installation, to a new password. This password should not be shared or forgotten by the administrator.
36. The schedules and reports for ANA should be printed from the SASAMS utility and any school that submits hand completed copies should also provide written reasons why they are doing so since Circular 26 of 2013 clearly instructed schools to use the SASAMS.
37. The schedules and the LURITS deployment form can be printed at the SASAMS hubs for schools that do not have printers.
38. The following items should be submitted to the district office:
 - a. LURITS deployment form (Signed)
 - b. ANA schedule with captured marks (signed)
 - c. Copy of the deployed database.
39. The District officials must commence capturing of Grades 1, 2, 4 and 5 Marksheets from the 25 September 2014 on the GET mainframe system.
40. Module * sub module 8.5 is utilised to capture marks on SASAMS.
41. If there are errors on the entries of learners on SASAMS these must be corrected before the marks are captured.
42. The marks must be captured by an educator, verified by the Head of Department and authorised by the Principal. If this process is not followed the marks cannot be utilised.
43. If a script is taken away by the Independent capture -2 in the mark column.
44. The Grade 3, 6 and 9 mark sheets must be captured immediately they are received from the moderation centre on the GET mainframe system. The last day for capture of marks on the GET mainframe system is 30 October 2014.



45. If there are duplicates on a mark sheet, a 999 must be entered against those learners examination number and only one mark must be entered against that learner. Ensure that the mark is captured against the same examination number for Language and Mathematics.
46. If a learner's information is incorrect on a mark sheet for example an Afrikaans learner is entered on an English mark sheet, a 999 must be entered on the mark sheet and a Manually Generated Mark sheet must be utilised.
47. The capturer must first amend the language on the system and then capture the mark.
48. The Independent agent will monitor the administration of the tests at the selected schools. The monitor will sample and collect 25 scripts after the administration of the tests and take them to the Independent Agent for marking. The invigilator will record the scripts that are removed by the independent agent and this record must be maintained at school.
49. After writing the test the selected 25 learners will be given a 20 minute break before these learners are requested to fill in a questionnaire by the independent agent.
50. Districts, Province, and the National Department of Basic Education will be monitoring the writing of ANA.

USERGUIDE: ANA MODULE FOR 2014

1. The SA-SAMS ANA Module assists schools in
 - capturing of learner assessments on the mark schedules
 - generating analysis schedules.
2. Validity of the captured data is improved by including a verification function by the HOD and then the Principal.
3. Marks can only be changed after the HOD and the Principal has removed their verification status.
4. The official schedule can only be printed after the principal has verified the analysis of the learner achievements and LURITS deployment is only possible after the principal's verification.

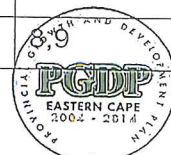
