**NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE EXAMINATION: PRESCRIBED FOLK NARRATIVES  
AND FOLK POETRY TITLES FOR STUDY IN GRADE 12 FOR ALL AFRICAN HOME  
LANGUAGES IN PUBLIC SCHOOL FROM 2015 ONWARDS**

The National Department of Education Circular S15 of 2014 refers.

On the 31 April 2014, the Department of Basic Education issued a catalogue for the Grade 12 folklore anthologies for the nine African Home Languages. However, the lists of titles for the




folk narratives and folk poetry to be studied as from 2015 were not yet compiled from these anthologies.

The Department of Basic Education, in consultation with examiners and moderators, has now compiled a list of folk narratives and folk poetry (praise poems / clan praises) from the folklore anthologies of the nine African Home Languages (**Annexure A**).

Although the folklore anthologies for each of the African Home Languages comprise seven (7) sub-genres as folk narratives, praise poems, clan praises folk songs, idioms, proverbs and riddles, the list provided as **Annexure A** does not include four of these seven sub-genres namely: folk songs, idioms, proverbs and riddles. Therefore, these four sub-genres will be infused in the assessment of the folk narratives and folk poetry.

The Department of Basic Education will provide an exam guideline for folklore in January 2015. This exam guideline will assist schools on how to assess and integrate folk songs, idioms, proverbs and riddles with the folk narratives and folk poetry.

All affected subject advisors, schools and teachers are hereby requested to take note of the information contained in this Assessment Instruction and action accordingly.




