It was brought to our attention that in the English FAL P2 Grade 6 November examination question paper, there are two references to the poem used in the paper that were not accurate. In order to ensure that learners are not disadvantaged the following must be brought to the attention of markers of the paper.

NO.	QUESTION	CORRECTION
12.	Rhyming words sound the same and is usually found at the end of a line.  E.g. boy sounds like toy.  Write down TWO words in <b>verse 6</b> that rhyme.	Write down TWO words in <b>verse 9–10</b> that rhyme.
	Learners were asked to write down two words from verse 6 that rhyme. (2 marks). There are no words in verse 6 that rhyme.	
13.	Which word in <b>verse 5</b> shows that the child is very unhappy about what the mother does?	Which word in <b>verse 8</b> shows that the child is very unhappy about what the mother does?
	Learners were asked to write down a word from verse 5 which means that that the child is very unhappy about what the mother does (2 marks). The word is not found in verse 5.

**Question 12:** Award 2 marks to learners.

**Question 13:** Award 2 marks to learners.

**Total number of marks:** 4 marks.
