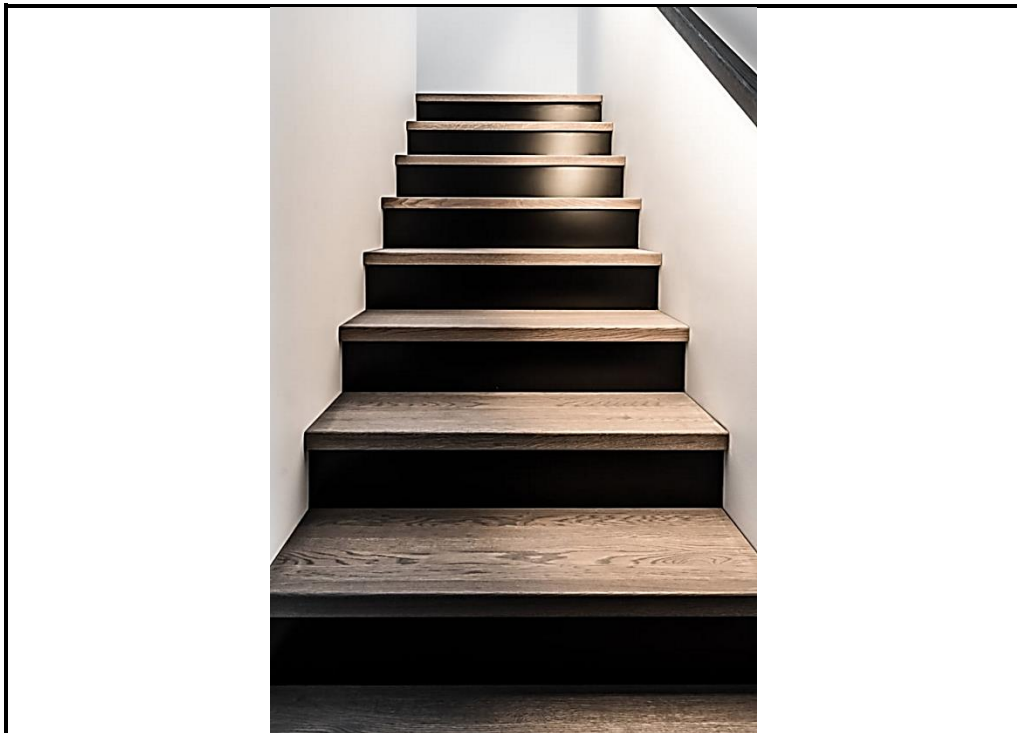
SECTION A: ESSAY**QUESTION 1**

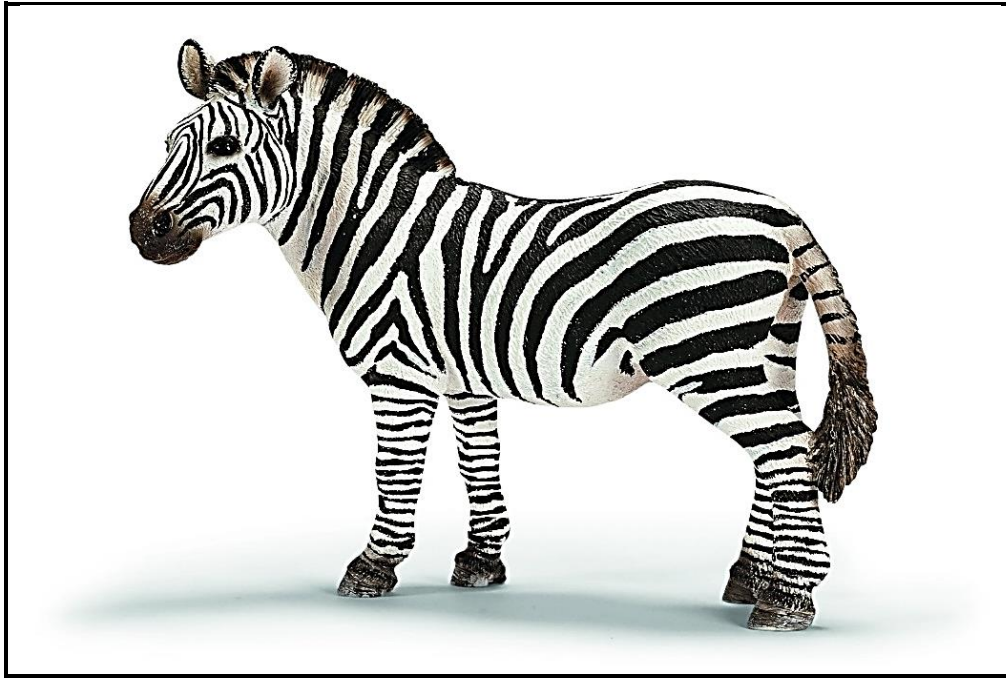
