#### 2019 REGISTRATION OF GRADE 12 NATIONAL SENIOR CERTIFICATE (NSC) LEARNERS

#### 1. INTRODUCTION

This Assessment Instruction deals with the registration of candidates for the 2019 National Senior Certificate (NSC) Examination. It outlines the categories of learners who may be registered by a registered school or a part-time district examination centre.

#### 2. LEARNERS WHO CAN BE REGISTERED FOR THE 2019 NSC EXAMINATION

#### 2.1 FULL-TIME LEARNERS

Grade 11 promotion schedules were generated through SASAMS and will be used to promote 2018 Grade 11 qualifying learners to 2019 Grade 12 full-time learners.

Please note that the due date for subject changes for 2019 Grade 12 learners was on 15 December 2018 and no new applications will be accepted.

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#### 2.2 FULL-TIME REPEATERS

- The Eastern Cape Department of Education affords all learners, who did not meet the requirements for the National Senior Certificate (NSC), an opportunity to return to school as full-time repeaters with them doing School Based Assessment (SBA), orals and practical assessment tasks (PATS) again in 2019.
- Previous marks for SBA, orals and PATS, for this category of learners are not carried over.
- Full-Time Repeat candidate's registration form is attached as Annexure A.

#### 2.2.1 REGISTERING A FULL-TIME REPEATER

- A learner must have written the National Senior Certificate Examination.
- Full-time repeaters can change <u>one</u> subject provided that the learner did not change a subject in his/her previous Grade 12 year(s).
- The deadline for the submission of the subject change for the full-time repeat learners is <u>31 January 2019</u> by schools to district examination offices with all necessary documentation.
- A statement of results or a schedule of results and a copy of an ID must be attached to the template and must be signed by the principal (Annexure A).
- Deadline for the submission of subject changes by districts to Head Office is
   8 February 2019.

#### 3. TRANSFERRED LEARNERS

#### 3.1 The following categories of learners are referred to as Transferred Learners:

- Learners who met the promotion or progression requirements for Grade 11 in other schools or provinces and who are seeking registration as 2019 Grade 12 NSC candidates in new schools.
- Learners who attended the same school in previous years from 2008, fulfilled
   Grade 11 NSC promotion requirements but could not return to school and register for Grade 12.
- Transferred learners' registration form is attached as Annexure B.

#### 3.2 REGISTERING A TRANSFERRED LEARNER

- A copy of the NSC Grade 11 report (compulsory) with contactable details and a transfer card MUST be attached to a transferred learner's registration form.
- No registration forms will be accepted by the district examination offices or the Provincial Office without these attachments (Annexure B).
- It is the responsibility of the principal to verify the validity of the school report submitted by the new learner at his/her school.
- The rate of fraudulent reports submitted by learners has drastically increased. Extra vigilance and care must thus be taken in the verification process.
- The validity of the documents of a transferred learner will also be checked by the District/Province on the promotion schedule of an Eastern Cape school.

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- If the learner is from another province, the validity of the documents will be checked by officials in the relevant province.
- Principals are urged to inform parents of this process and to **register these learners provisionally** until notification of their registration in the 2019 NSC Grade 12.
- A change of subject will only be registered if a request was made before the due date, 15 December 2018 and approved by the Provincial Office.

#### 4. REPEAT (PART-TIME) CANDIDATES

- **4.1** Learners who did not meet the requirements for 2008 2018 National Senior Certificate can register and improve one or more NSC subjects in 2019. To register as a part-time candidate for NSC in 2019, the learners must meet the following requirements:
  - Learners must be in possession of a 2008 2018 NSC Statement of results issued by the National Department of Basic Education.
  - This means that the candidate must have written the NSC examination between 2008– 2018.
  - Learners may only register for NCS subjects.
  - Learners may register for one or more subjects.
  - Candidates may change only one subject from those studied in the previous years provided that the candidate did not change a subject in his/her Grade 12 previous year(s).
  - For the new subject to be registered, a candidate must register at a <u>full-time registered</u> centre for tuition in the new subject.
  - A written confirmation by the full-time registered centre to provide SBA MUST be attached to the registration form.

# 4.2 DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED TO REGISTER A REPEAT (PART-TIME) CANDIDATES

- A South African ID book. This is compulsory, no candidate will be registered without it. Affidavits are not accepted.
- A part time registration form which will serve as a proof of registration must be completed in full (Annexure C).
- A copy of 2008 2018 NSC Statement of results.
- In the case of a candidate who has changed a subject, a letter from the <u>Principal of a registered school that will provide tuition, assess and moderate SBA, Oral and PAT marks</u> for the subject where no recorded marks are available, must be submitted.
- The candidate must agree to present himself/herself at the District Office to sign all preliminary entry schedules and to collect an admission letter to the examination that will give him/her access to the examination room.
- The District Office will issue the applicant with a proof of registration (COMPULSORY). (Annexure C).

#### 4.3 INSTRUCTIONS TO PRINCIPAL

- Principals of schools are required to accurately complete the attached form on the analysis of candidate's numbers per subject and language version as part of the documentation required to complete the Grade 12 learners' registration process as well as printing of papers (Annexure D).
- Schools are informed that there will be no printing of dual question papers hence the language version of each subject has to be clearly indicated.
- Declaration on the correctness of the NSC Grade 12 learners' entries in respect of all the three categories of learners registering in a school must be completed and submitted (Annexure E).

#### 5. CLOSING DATES

- Grade 12 Full-Time Repeaters: Friday, 15 February 2019.
- Grade 12 Transferred Learners: Friday, 15 February 2019.
- Part-Time Candidates: Friday, 15 February 2019.

#### 6. CONCLUSION

Examinations and Assessment Chief Directorate strives to administer examinations with zero defect. This can only be achieved if the registration of all candidates is error-free. Principals are expected to disseminate this information widely to ensure that the class of 2019 can access higher education institutions and follow the career paths of their choice.
