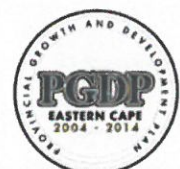

3. The June common examinations will be written by schools with subjects that have performed less than 70% during 2018 NSC examinations, in the following subjects:

  - 2) Agricultural Sciences
  - 3) Business Studies
  - 4) Economics Paper 1 and Paper 2
  - 5) Geography Paper 1 and Paper 2




- 6) History Paper 1 and Paper 2
