SUBJECT: COMBINATION OF GRADE 12 RESULTS

DATE: 24 JANUARY 2022

1. The National Senior Certificate (NSC) results have been announced and issued to schools and candidates on 21 January 2022.
2. There are candidates who wrote the examinations more than once and are eligible to combine their results, if they qualify.
3. The following is a table that illustrates different categories of combinations and their requirements:

CATEGORY	REQUIREMENTS
1. Combination of NSC+ NSC	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• The candidate must have minimum seven subjects and must pass six subjects including HL and LIFE to qualify for the NSC Certificate.• The requirement to obtain Bachelor's must pass 4 subjects with 50% excluding Life Orientation.• The requirement to obtain Diploma must pass 4 subjects with 40% excluding Life Orientation• The requirement to obtain Higher Certificate must pass 3 subjects with 40%• In all cases above the candidate must pass two official languages, HL with 40%• NB: We don't combine NCV results with NSC results





2. Combination of NSC and Senior Certificate Amended

- The candidate must have minimum 6 subjects and must pass 5 subjects and the sixth subject must be 20% to qualify for the Senior Certificate.
- If the candidate pass all 5 subjects and get 10% on the sixth subject the candidate does not qualify for the certificate
- The requirements to obtain Bachelor's must pass 4 subjects with 50%
- The requirements to obtain Diploma must pass 4 subjects with 40%
- The requirements to obtain Higher certificate must pass 3 subjects with 40%
- In all cases above the candidate must pass two official languages, HL with 40%
- No Life Orientation for NSC & SC(a) combination
- No NCV results for NSC & SC(a) combination

3. Combination of NATED 550 & NSC & SC(a)

- If the candidate offered a mix of SC (Nated 550), NSC and SC(a) 20 credit subjects, and passes with an achievement rating of 4 (50%) or better in at least four subjects which must be Higher Grade and NSC or SC(a)
- If the candidate pass all 5 subjects and get 10% on the sixth subject the candidate does not qualify for the certificate.
- The requirements to obtain Bachelor's must pass 4 subjects with 50%
- The requirements to obtain Diploma must pass 4 subjects with 40%
- The requirements to obtain Higher certificate must pass 3 subjects with 40%
- In all cases above the candidate must pass two official languages, HL with 40%
- No Life Orientation for NSC & SC(a) combination
- N3 results can be combined with SC(a) results but only Business English and Business Afrikaans other subjects are not allowed.





4. REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- Certified Statement of Results.
- Certified ID copy.

5. TARRIFFS

- R141.00 if an applicant qualifies for a combination.
- R52.00 if the applicant does not qualify for a combination after his/her results have been processed.

6. The different categories of combinations as outlined above can be obtained in all twelve (12) Districts.
