MEMORANDUM 06 OF 2022

This correspondence has reference: Assessment Instruction no 17 of 2022; Memoranda dated; 14 April 2022; 21 April 2022; 22 April 2022; 04 May 2022; and 09 May 2022.

- The first document above, invited qualified applicants to apply **online** as markers for the Nov/Dec NSC grade 12 examination marking.
- After that, numerous memos as stated above were issued in an attempt to ensure that all deserving applicants have successfully applied. That is inclusive of the video tutorial which was also part of the memos sent to provide more clarity on how to undergo the processing of an application form by the applicants from the start up to the last stage, submitting application.
- It is with high appreciation of all stakeholders including Teacher Unions that contributed to the success of this 'new' method of applying for markers. A total number of **7343 markers** have been chronicled in the system, which is even more than the average number during the years of manual application forms. Thus, significantly indicates the success of this programme so far. The approximate number of markers required is +_ 5500.
- It must be further noted that the above number in the system report includes few educators/applicants who could not finish uploading of their documents and



final submission of the application forms as well as those that experienced some difficulties even in starting the online marker application, as they were individually assisted by the provincial office.

- Further to note, much as the deadline for the system to close were set, it was never literally closed to allow the process to conclude smoothly with everybody in. On 01 June 2022 at 18h00, the system will be closed completely and prepared for the next phase, which is the district verification, followed by the provincial marker selection process.
- District marker verification will be done online by the panel constituted in terms of the provisions pertaining to the recruitment processes, as per the outline in the above-mentioned Assessment Instruction. - Username passwords to be used during the verification process will be forwarded through emails to the districts, relevant subject advisers, per district per subject.
