SUBJECT: ERRATA – SCOPE OF JUNE 2022 PROVINCIAL ASSESSMENT MATERIAL
(MATHEMATICS P1 and P2)

1. In the wake of the COVID-19 lockdowns and the resulting loss of learning and teaching time, the Department of Basic Education saw the need to effectively trim the curriculum across all grades. This necessitated a shift in the Annual Teaching Plans and some portions of the curriculum were moved to be covered in different parts of the year. As a result of the fragmented nature of the teaching time brought about by the pandemic, it meant that different schools were covering different parts of the trimmed curriculum at the end of Grade 11 in 2021.
2. It has come to the attention of the Eastern Department of Education that these shifts in the trimmed curriculum were not adequately compensated for in the setting of the June 2022 **Mathematics** papers.
3. In order to ensure equity and to ensure that when diagnostic assessment and evaluation of the examinations is performed in can done with a reasonable accuracy. After consideration of many options and the welfare of learners uppermost in our minds the following decision was taken: It has been subsequently decided to ignore those aspects of the question papers which may not have been covered as yet in accordance with the trimmed curriculum (we are acutely aware some schools may have covered the sections in question).

4. The papers will therefore be marked out of a lower total and learners' marks are to be converted to the original total/percentage for recording purposes. The duration for **Mathematics Paper 1** will be **2½ hours** and **NOT 3 hours**.
5. Candidates are not required to write the following questions:
