#### GRADE 12 MAY/JUNE 2022 EXAMINATION TIMETABLE

3. The May/June 2022 examination subjects are scheduled to be written from Monday, 9 May 2022 to Thursday, 23 June 2022.
4. The May/June examination is an examination that is identical to the October/November 2021 examinations and all subjects offered in the October/November 2021 examination will be offered in the May/June 2022 examination. However, candidates registered for the Senior Certificate can only write the subjects marked with an asterisk (\*).
5. Two sessions are scheduled for each day of the examination in terms of all the timetables. The morning session will commence at 9:00 and the afternoon session will continue at 14:00.

6. The re-write opportunity for Computer Applications Technology Paper 1 (CAT P1) and Information Technology Paper 1 (IT P1) will take place on 23 June 2022.
7. The heads of educational institutions should ensure that the content of this circular is distributed to all affected teachers, learners, subject advisors and other relevant stakeholders.
