- This Assessment Instruction has a reference the reference to the National Circular S4 of 2024.
- 2. In 2023, the Department of Basic Education (DBE) released Circular S8 of 2023 to inform all Provincial Education Departments (PEDs) and stakeholders, about the amended School-Based Assessment (SBA) weightings relating to the Programme of Assessment (POA) for the Further Education and Training (FET) Band. The SBA weightings had to be amended so that it is aligned with the Revised Annual Teaching Plans (R-ATPS)


