## THE 2024 NSC OCTOBER /NOVEMBER TIMETABLE AND RELEASE OF RESULTS OF THE 2024 OCTOBER/NOVEMBER EXAMINATION

- At the Council of Educators Ministers (CEM) meeting held on the Thursday 7 March 2024, the 2024 October/November National Senior Certificate examination timetable (ANNEXURE A), and the date of the release of the results was discussed and approved.
- 2. The 2024 NSC examination timetable follows the same format as the 2023 October/November timetable except for the following changes:
  - (a) Computer Applications Technology (CAT) Practical (P1) and Information Technology (IT) Practical (P1) will be written during Week 1 of the examinations, and not a week before the commencement of the examinations.
  - (b) In Week 1, Paper 3 for all the Official Languages (English, Afrikaans, isiZulu, isiXhosa, isiNdebele, Sesotho, Setswana, Sepedi, siSwati Tshivenda, and Xitsonga), will be written. Paper 3 in all the Languages comprises: Creative Writing.
    Candidates must be reminded that Paper 3 will be written, before Paper 1 and 2.
- 3. The examination officially commences on the **21 October 2024** with the writing of English Home Language P3, English First Additional Language P3 and English Second Additional Language P3 and will conclude on the **28 November 2024**.

- 4. The examinations for Computer Applications Technology (CAT) Practical P1 and Information Technology (IT) Practical P1 are scheduled to be administered on 22 October 2024 and 23 October 2024 respectively. The re-write opportunity for CAT and IT will take place on 28 November 2024.
- 5. The Life Orientation (LO) Common Assessment Task will be written on **Monday**, 2 **September 2024**, with the re-write (i.e. LO Common Assessment Task) scheduled for **Thursday 3 October 2024**.
- 6. The Performing Arts Practical is scheduled for **Monday 12 August to Monday 14 October 2024**, and Visual Arts and Design Practical's are scheduled for **Tuesday 1 to Monday 14 October 2024**.
- 7. The Minister will announce the 2024 October/November examination results on **Wednesday**, **15 January 2025**, and the Provincial Education Departments (PEDs) will release the results of candidates on **Thursday**, **16 January 2025**.
- 8. The heads of educational institutions should ensure that the content of this Assessment Instruction is distributed to all Grade 12 teachers, learners, subject advisors, and other relevant stakeholders.
