1. The 2026 NSC Grade 12 Preparatory Examination plays a crucial role in the preparation of learners for the final NSC Grade 12 October/November 2026 Examination. It provides an opportunity for learners, educators, and other role players to measure their readiness. The setting and roll-out of the preparatory examination resembles the final NSC examination, therefore this prepares them for the final examination.
2. The DRAFT timetable for the 2026 NSC Grade 12 Preparatory examination is attached as **ANNEXURE A**. It is important to note that the examination will take place during a period designated by the DBE. The examination is thus scheduled for:

3. The Life Orientation (LO) Common Task will be written on **Tuesday, 1 September 2026**, with its rewrite (i.e. LO Common Assessment task) scheduled for **Monday, 12 October 2026**.
4. Schools are reminded to set their own question papers for the subjects which do not appear on this timetable and find a suitable slot within the existing timetable. Question papers set at school level, must be moderated by expert teachers/district subject advisors.
5. Comments and considerate suggestions on the draft timetable should be e-mailed to fezeka.ntsangani@ecdoe.gov.za no later than **Monday, 13 July 2026**.
6. Note that any changes or amendments to the draft timetable should have a valid educational basis, clashes refer to subjects offered being written at the **same time**. The timetable was developed keeping in mind various factors and variables. Various logistics and provincial dynamics were considered.
7. Schools and other educational institutions are also reminded that this Examination provides an opportunity to test and evaluate the procedures and systems for the final examination.
