I, Grace Naledi Mandisa Pandor, Minister of Education, hereby, in terms of *Sections 3(4)(l) and 7 of the National Education Policy Act, 1996 (Act No. 27 of 1996)*, approve the following amendments to *paragraphs 10(9), 10(10) and 11(1)(a)-(f) of the schools' policy document, The National Senior Certificate: A qualification at Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF)* to read as follows:

*Paragraph 10(9):* "A candidate may not offer both Computer Applications Technology and Information Technology."

*Paragraph 10(10): Paragraph 10(10):* "A candidate may not offer both Consumer Studies and Hospitality Studies."

*Paragraph 11(1)(a)-(f):* "To obtain the National Senior Certificate a learner must achieve 40% in three subjects, one of which is an official language at Home Language level, and 30% in three subjects, provided that a complete portfolio of evidence in the school-based assessment component is submitted in the subject failed."

No. 84 of 1996)*, approve the following amendments to *paragraphs 10(9), 10(10) and 11(1)(a)-(f)* of the schools' policy document, *The National Senior Certificate: A qualification at Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF)* published by means of a *Government Notice, No.744*, in the *Government Gazette, Vol.481, No.27819* of 20 July 2005. The amendments are listed in Annexure A.

The amendments contained in Annexure A reflect: (a) the minimum outcomes and standards; and (b) the processes and procedures for the assessment of learner achievement as contained in the policy document, *The National Senior Certificate: A qualification at Level 4 on the National Qualifications Framework (NQF)*.

The amendments are applicable to both public and independent schools.
