Brief summary: The structure of Grade 12 Business Studies Examination Paper

This Circular No. 7 of 2013 should be read in conjunction with the Business Studies Curriculum and Assessment Policy Statement (CAPS) issued by the Department of Basic Education in January 2012.

In order to assist teachers and learners at schools in their preparation for the Grade 12 examination, Circular No. 7 of 2013 seeks to clarify the structure of the Business Studies Examinations Paper in the Further Education Training (FET) band as it appears in the CAPS.
